## Pick the Proper Caps Answer Key

1. **C** - *We are going to the beach on Friday.*  
(Capitalize first word of sentence and days of the week; "beach" is not a proper noun here.)
2. **B** - *My dog Max loves to chase balls.*  
(Capitalize first word of sentence and pet's name.)
3. **B** - *Yesterday, we visited the White House in Washington, D.C.*  
(Capitalize first word, landmarks, and places properly.)
4. **D** - *"Where are you going?" she asked.*  
(Capitalize first word in quotation; "she" is not capitalized mid-sentence.)
5. **C** - *Uncle John took me to see the Statue of Liberty.*  
(Capitalize family title with name and monument's name.)
6. **B** - *On Christmas, my family travels to Arizona.*  
(Capitalize holidays, states, and first word of a sentence.)

### Teacher Notes

- This activity strengthens recognition of **capitalization rules** in full sentences rather than isolated words.
- Students must carefully compare options, which helps develop **proofreading skills**.
- To extend: Ask students to create their own multiple-choice set with one correct and three incorrect capitalization options.
